



## VANDENBERG VILLAGE COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT

### Demonstration Garden

In Spring 2007, the District used Water Conservation funds, collected from developers, to transform the landscaping outside the District office into a demonstration garden showcasing "sustainable landscaping" plants and ground covers. Sustainable landscaping is in balance with the local climate and requires minimal resource inputs such as fertilizer, pesticides, and water. The project also includes a small section of synthetic turf which is gaining popularity because it requires no water and virtually no maintenance. The staff hopes residents will consider these options which enhance the curb appeal of their homes and conserve water.

### Cash 4 Grass Rebate

Vandenberg Village residents may be eligible for a rebate of up to \$2.00 per sq. ft. (max \$1,000) to replace grass with low water usage plants, rocks, or synthetic turf.

The District will require before and after pictures as well as receipts to determine rebate eligibility.

















